2. Smaller bodies of still water surrounded by land, often shallower than lakes.



L K A E

5. Large bodies of freshwater surrounded by land. They can vary in size from small ponds to vast expanses.



R V I E R

3. Large, flat areas of land that are higher than the surrounding land.



S R T E A M S

6. Smaller versions of rivers, typically narrower channels of flowing water.
