
## **Word Problems**

Directions: Read and understand each word problem. Place your answer inside the box.


1. Mark has **two** apples. Later that day, the teacher gave him **four** more apples. How many apples does Mark have

now?




2. My sister bought **ten** marbles this afternoon. Since it's her birthday, I gave her **five** more marbles. How many
